

Hi OVC Campers. I hope you and your families are safe and healthy. I want to give an update on the current plans for the opening of the campground. This is a stressful time for everyone, and so many of us want to find a safe way to "stay home" at our campers and spend time outside while keeping our "social distance". This is the plan today and can change at any time.

OVC is planning to open a little early this year. What a blessing that the weather has been so nice. The electric is on and we will start working on the water tomorrow. We should be good to go by the weekend. It really is critical for us to have the water on so that campers can use their own bathrooms. Also, please consider that this may increase the demand for the honey wagon. We ask that you do your best to conserve water, particularly if you have no gray sewer.

The plan is to have families "stay home" at their designated campsites. This gives families a chance to be together at their campsite and outside in the campground BUT NO PEOPLE OR CHILDREN OR FAMILIES CAN BE TOGETHER WITH OTHER FAMILIES. Camping and being outside with our families can be great but we have to do it right. As part of being responsible and safe, we will be opening with the following changes and rules.

- There will be no tent camping until further notice.
- NO OUTSIDE VISITORS. Only the people listed on the site license and their IMMEDIATE FAMILY will be allowed on the premises. No grandchildren or grandparents.
- THE REC HALL, ARCADE, POOL AND BATHROOMS WILL BE COMPLETELY CLOSED, until further notice. The Laundry room will be open, but we will keep it locked so we can monitor it. You can request the key by calling 845-754-8732.

- The office and store will be opened only when something is needed. Questions, payments, check ins, and everything else will be coordinated over the phone. Call us at 845-754-8732
- KIDS CANNOT PLAY ON THE PLAYGROUNDS even if they are the only one. Playgrounds, and volleyball will all be closed.

Social Distancing rules and examples:

- Stand 6 feet away from people. No personal contact.
- Children absolutely cannot play with other children. If you are unable to keep your children away from others, please do not stay at the campground at this time.
- No talking in groups right next to each other.
- No sitting at a picnic table with other families.
- No sitting on someone else's deck.
- No riding or sitting in someone else's golf cart.
- DO NOT VISIT OTHER SITES. STAY HOME.

THIS A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY. IF WE SEE PEOPLE ON A SITE OTHER THAN THEIR OWN, YOU WILL ALL BE ASKED TO LEAVE UNTIL THE PANDEMIC IS OVER.
