OKLAND VALLEY CAMPGROUND SWIMMING POOL RULES

1. There is NO lifeguard on duty at any time. NO DIVING or RUNNING, and DON'T SWIM WHILE INTOXICATED.

2. NEVER SWIM ALONE. A minimum of 2 adults, 18 years of age or older, MUST be present whenever this swimming facility is in use, with one adult on deck. ONLY REGISTERED GUESTS MAY USE THE FACILITIES.

3. THERE IS NO SUBSTITUE FOR ADEQUATE SUPERVISION. Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult for their safety & behavior while at the bathing facility.

4. CHILDREN UNDER 3 YEARS OF AGE & NOT TOLIET TRAINED MUST WEAR SWIMMMIES. (Available at camp store).

NO DIAPERS ALLOWED.

5. NO FOOD, DRINKS, GLASSWARE, CIGARETTES/CIGARS ARE ALLOWED IN THE POOL AREA.

6. People using lotion or oil, MUST shower before using pool

7. IN an emergency, notify the facility operator & contact help as soon as possible. A FREE phone is provided at the office/store. Telephone numbers for the nearest

emergency medical services are posted.

8. NO RUNNING, ROUGH HOUSE PLAYING, PUSHING, URINATING, POOPING, SPITTING OR BLOWING YOUR NOSE IN THE POOL.

9. PERSONS having open sores, nose discharge or communicable diseases, WILL NOT be permitted in enter the POOL.

10. No vehicles parked at the bathing facility shall play LOUD or OFFENSIVE music.

11. ONLY use the pool during posted hours of operation.

12. If any of the swimming rules are violated you will be asked to leave the pool area.
